EASTER

Easter is the most important festival in the Christian church year. People who are not Christians celebrate it as a cultural spring holiday full of traditions and customs. Easter comes at a different time each year. This is because Easter Sunday is the Sunday after the first full moon after the first day of spring (March 21). Therefore, it can be held on Sunday between March 22 and April 25. Exchanging and eating Easter eggs is a popular custom in many countries. Eggs are a symbol of spring and rebirth in most cultures. People decorate them with different colours using special techniques. Traditionally bright colours represent spring and light. Nowadays children prefer getting Easter eggs made of chocolate. In the UK children believe that Easter Bunny hides eggs around the home or garden. They take baskets and go for Easter egg hunt. Some people still carry out the custom of egg rolling.
